

NWT VETERAN'S LICENCE PLATE QUALIFICATIONS

GENERAL

Northwest Territories Veterans' Licence Plates are issued by the Northwest Territories Registrar under the provisions of Section 8(2)(m) of the Motor Vehicle Registration and Licence Plate Regulations R-054-94. The Veterans' Licence Plate is deemed to be a personalized plate; therefore, the plate cannot be affixed to a non-personal vehicle such as a commercial, public service or rental vehicle. Further, the Veterans' Licence Plate cannot be registered to a motorcycle. Once the Veteran is deceased, the licence plate can no longer be used and must be removed from the vehicle.

ELIGIBILITY

A Northwest Territories Veterans' Licence is available to any person who has honourably:

- Served (may still be serving) in the Armed Forces of Canada, the Commonwealth, or its wartime Allies for a minimum of three years (1095 days);
- Served in the Merchant Navy or Ferry Command during wartime;
- Served in a theatre of war with the Armed Forces of Canada, the Commonwealth or its wartime Allies; or
- Performed NATO Service or Peacekeeping mission(s) with the Armed Forces of Canada.

APPLICATION

As stipulated in Section 4.02.04 of the GNWT DVLP Policy Manual, eligible Veterans must complete the application form available on the GNWT website <https://www.idmv.dot.gov.nt.ca/Vehicles/Licence-Plate/Order-a-veteran-licence-plate>

The applicant will forward the completed application to any of the Legion Branches within the Northwest Territories, along with proof of eligibility, for certification.

Once eligibility is confirmed, the Branch will forward the application and proof of eligibility to the Alberta-NWT Command Office for review and approval. If approved, the Command approving authority will then forward the application to the GNWT's Compliance and Licensing Division at:

On receipt of the approved application by that division, the applicant will be notified to proceed to the nearest Driver and Vehicle Services office to register for a Veterans' Licence Plate. Their fee is \$36.00 plus cost of the registration.
